LOCAL RULES

OUT OF BOUNDS RULE 27

- Outside Boundary of Course, Putting Green, Car Park, Area to right of 13th tee, Quarry and left of the 10th fairway, and all Internal Plantations marked by white stakes.

WATER HAZARDS RULE 26

- As defined by yellow stakes.
- Lateral Water Hazards - as defined by red stakes. Note stakes or lines defining the margins of hazards are in the hazard.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR RULE 25

- All ground marked G.U.R.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS 24.2

- All paths, seats, sprinkler heads, rain shelters, signs, litter bins, tee markers staked trees, distance markers, stone drains. Bell right of the 4th fairway, relief under rule 24-2.
- All watering installations. In addition sprinkler heads - if a ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and is within two club lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where it lay which a) is not nearer the hole, b) avoids such intervention and c) is not a hazard or on a putting green, without penalty.
- Fixed tee markers, fixed seats, fixed signs, ball washers and distance markers.

INTEGRAL PART OF THE COURSE

- Pump house on the right of the 16th tee, net right of 12th tee and wall right of 14th fairway.

BREACH OF THE LOCAL RULES:

- Match play: Loss of Hole Strokeplay: Two Strokes

EMBEDDED BALL

- Through the green, a ball that is embedded in its own pitch mark in the ground may be lifted, without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to where it lay but not nearer the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green.

Exception 1: A player may not take relief under this Local Rule if it is embedded in sand in an area that is not closely mown.

Exception 2: A player may not take relief under this Local Rule if it is clearly unreasonable for him to make a stroke because of interference by anything other than the condition covered by this Local Rule.

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES RULE 14-3

- A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure or gauge other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature etc...) the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually needed.

ANY TEMPORARY LOCAL RULES

- Defined on the Notice Board.
